

**2026 WARRANT**  
**Town of Rindge, State of New Hampshire**

To the inhabitants of the Town of Rindge in the State of New Hampshire qualified to vote in Town affairs:

FIRST SESSION: You are hereby notified to meet for the First (Deliberative) Session of the Annual Town Meeting, to be held at the Rindge Memorial Elementary School, 58 School Street, Rindge, NH on Saturday, the 31<sup>st</sup> day of January 2026 at 9:00 a.m. The First Deliberative Session will consist of explanation, discussion and debate of articles and will afford those voters who are present the opportunity to propose, debate and adopt amendments to each warrant article, except the election of officers and warrant articles whose wording is prescribed by state law.

SECOND SESSION: You are also notified to meet for the Second Session of the Annual Town Meeting on Tuesday, the 10th day of March 2026, at the Rindge Memorial Elementary School, 58 School Street, Rindge NH between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. to vote by official ballot to elect Town officers, to vote by official ballot on warrant articles as they may have been amended at the First Session and to vote on those other official ballot questions whose wording is prescribed by state law.

Article 1      Officers for the Year Ensuing

To choose by ballot all necessary Town Officers for the ensuing year:

To see if the Town shall vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Hundred Fifty-Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) to be added to the Highway Department Equipment Fund previously established, and further to name the Board of Selectmen as agents to expend from said fund. (Majority vote required). (Recommended by the Selectmen 2 in favor, 1 opposed) (Recommended by the Budget Advisory Committee 7 in favor, 0 opposed).

Article 7      Municipal Building CRF

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Thirty Five Thousand dollars (\$35,000) to be added to the Building Maintenance Capital Reserve Fund. (Recommended by the Selectmen X in favor, X opposed) (Recommended by the Budget Advisory Committee X in favor, X opposed).

BOS were named as agents to expend in 2020

Article 8      Recreation Facilities CRF

To see if the Town shall vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) to be added to the Recreation Facilities Capital Reserve Fund previously established. (Majority vote required). (Recommended by the Selectmen X in favor, X opposed) (Recommended by the Budget Advisory Committee X in favor, X opposed).

Article 9      Meetinghouse Maintenance ETF

To see if the Town shall vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) to be added to the Meetinghouse Maintenance Expendable Trust Fund previously established. (Majority vote required). (Recommended by the Selectmen 3 in favor, 0 opposed) (Recommended by the Budget Advisory Committee 7 in favor, 0 opposed).

Article 10     Adoption of Farm Structure Exemption

To see if the Town will vote to adopt the provisions of RSA 79F regarding the taxation of farm structures, as defined in RSA 79-F:3, and the land under farm structures.

Article 11     Veterans Disability Tax Credit Increase

To see if the Town will vote, pursuant to RSA 72:35, to increase the amount of the tax credit for service-connected permanent and total disability to Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars.

Article 13      USA 250<sup>th</sup> Celebration (Placeholder)

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate Five Thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the purpose of celebrating the United States' 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

Article 14 Ingalls Memorial Library ETF

To see if the Town shall vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Twenty-Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) to be added to the Ingalls Memorial Library Expendable Trust Fund previously established. (Majority vote required). (Recommended by the Selectmen 3 in favor, 0 opposed) (Recommended by the Budget Advisory Committee 5 in favor, 2 opposed).
